## Coordination within Fragmentation – Insights on Governing Canada's Innovation Agenda

Policy coordination to support coherent research policy has become a major governance puzzle for most countries. By interviewing 40 experts from the government, industry and higher education sector in Ontario, this study examines the factors that shape policy coordination, providing insights on mechanisms that could facilitate collaboration in Canada's innovation policy.
